If you want their seat, please ask them or ask the bartender to ask them.

We hold a **Queen of Hearts** drawing every Thursday. Tickets are \$1 each or 6 for \$5. Drawing is at 8 PM. You must be present, be a 2018 regular member of a VSO (no associate/honorary member-ships accepted) & pick the Queen of Hearts to win. The pot to be shared in our 5th fundraiser is over \$2,000.

Do not use the Handicap parking spaces for over-night parking.

All kitchen workers (lunches, Friday steak crews, Saturday dinners, Monday/Tuesday sandwich nights) are volunteers who depend on tips. Please remember to tip them.

We have **Bingo on Monday nights** from 6:30 to 8:30 and have a progressive lucky ball jackpot. **The Riders are serving burgers, hot dogs, FF and specials.** We conduct bingo every Tuesday and Thursday at 2 PM with a progressive lucky ball jackpot.

Riders will be doing Wing Night on Thursday the 18th and the Post will have Karaoke.

Red Shirt Friday drink specials will continue every Friday. You must be wearing a red shirt to get the special. Wear your NFL clothing on Sundays and get the drink special.

MEAL SERVICE

We ask your cooperation in not bringing in or ordering outside food during times someone is serving food. Remember, they are donating their time and effort to prepare, serve and clean up. The meals are fund raisers for our various programs. If you do not wish to buy the meal, please eat before you come to the Post or wait until the meal is done. Please do not bring in your own <u>snacks, sodas, water</u>, etc., <u>at any time</u> as we sell those items.

When you sign in a guest, that guest must leave when you leave.

Steak Bingo is conducted at 6 PM every Friday steak night. 8 games are conducted-7 for steaks and 1 for road kill (ribs).

As a reminder, the bartender's priority is serving drinks to the customers at the bar and in the line. If you wish to be served, use the waitress station-do not stand at the end of the bar or between people sitting at the bar. If you want to redeem or buy a ticket for any machine, you will have to wait. The Post has 72 hours to pay out on the machines and the bartenders cannot pay tickets of \$500 or more or prior day tickets. You are limited to redeeming \$1,000 a day. If the bartender runs out of money, you will have to return later. The Manager will only redeem tickets Monday through Friday during normal business hours.

We serve lunch Monday—Friday from 11 AM to 1 PM.

NEW MEDICARE CARDS

Medicare is mailing new Health Insurance ID cards to its 60 million members. The new cards replace you Social Security number with newly assigned ID numbers as your identification. The ID number consists of a unique combi-nation of 11 letters and numbers. The cards are free and scammers are already posing as Medicare representatives and calling or emailing beneficiaries demanding a processing fee to issue them. Other fraudsters are telling beneficiaries that they are owed a refund from transactions on their old card, then asking for bank account information to process the reimbursement. Medicare will never ask an enrollee for bank account numbers, and no refunds are owed. Scammers are also asking for payments to replace cards that may be lost. Mailing the new cards to members is a yearlong process that began in May 2018. To learn more about when your card will arrive, go to Medicare.gov/ NewCard.

Disaster Scams during Hurricane Season

With hurricane season running through November 30, you should be aware that criminals and scammers try to take advantage of generous people. Disaster scams normally start with unsolicited contact by email, social media, telephone or in-person using a variety of tactics to lure info out of you. Some examples: thieves pretend they are from a charity and try to get money or private info; bogus websites use names similar to legitimate charities to trick people to send money or personal info; scammers claim to work for or on behalf of the IRS and can help victims file casualty loss claims or get tax refunds. The Tax Exempt Organization Search section of IRS.gov helps users who want to make donations find or verify qualified charities for which donations may be tax deductible. One could also call the IRS toll-free disaster assistance line at 866-562-5227 to get answers about tax relief or disaster-related tax issues. One should always contribute by check or credit card to have a record of the donation. Donors should never give out personal financial info like Social Security numbers or credit card/bank account numbers and passwords to anyone who solicits donations.
