Membership Eligibility Change

Congress has passed and the President has signed into law the Legion Act which establishes new eligibility dates for membership in The American Legion. Basically, if you have served one day on active duty any time from Dec 7, 1941 to a future date not yet determined by Congress and have an honorable discharge or are still on active duty, you are now eligible for membership in The American Legion.

SMOKING POLICY

An idea was expressed to build an area to expand the east side of the building toward the parking lot that could be designated a smoking or a non-smoking area. If anyone has any skills to coordinate the effort, please volunteer to help. Al Yardley is working on a screened in enclosure. 2020 Membership

Please remember, You cannot pay your 2020 dues by credit card. The Post does not process credit cards (there is an ATM), so we sent renewals with the credit card information to Department for processing. Since we now report and pay National and Dept dues online, Department will no longer process our credit card payments. The Post will return renewals with credit card information and ask for a check or for payment to be made online. Reminder, if you pay online, you will be charged the full \$40 dues payment as National only recognizes our official dues. You must send your payment to the Post to take advantage of our discounts (when you use the renewal notice, your payment comes to the Post).

You can renew online by visiting www.legion.org/renew. You can also register for the Automatic Annual Renewal Program. The Post cannot process credit card payments-we send them to Department. You must include your credit card number and expiration date.

You can only Pay Up For Life online and the \$100 discount is still in effect. Just visit legion.org, search for PUFL offer.

2019 dues are \$40 for ages 59 and younger (\$35 during the Early Bird period from July 1 to November 11), \$32 for 60 and older. Our 3-year renewals are \$100 for 59 and younger and \$90 for 60 and older. If you pay online to national or by credit card, you will be charged \$40-national only recognizes our official dues. You can only get discounted rates by paying \$32 to the Post utilizing the renewal notice.

Customer Consideration: Please do not move other customer's drinks, money or property at the bar as this causes issues and accusations. If you want their seat, please ask them or ask the bartender to ask them.

We hold a Queen of Hearts contest every Thursday. Drawing is at 8 PM. You must be present, be a 2019 regular member of a VSO (no associate/honorary member-ships accepted) & pick the Queen of Hearts to win.

DO NOT USE Handicap parking spaces for overnight parking.

All kitchen workers (lunches, Friday steak crews, Saturday dinners, Monday/Tuesday sandwich nights) are volunteers who depend on tips. Please remember to tip the kitchen workers.

Bingo is on Monday nights at 6:30 and has a progressive lucky ball jackpot. The Riders are serving burgers, hot dogs, French fries and specials. We conduct Bingo every Tuesday and Thursday at 2 PM with a progressive lucky ball jackpot.

Riders Wing Night is Thursday the 19th.

Pass the Trash is Wednesday night at 7 PM. Come early to get a seat at the bar. If you would like to deal, please let Liz know.

Red shirt Friday drink specials are served every Friday. You must be wearing a <u>RED</u> shirt to get the special.

Wear NASCAR clothes during race season and NEL clothes

Wear NASCAR clothes during race season and NFL clothes during football season for drink specials.

MEAL SERVICE

We ask your cooperation in not bringing in or ordering outside food during times someone is serving food. Remember, they are donating their time and effort to prepare, serve and clean up. The meals are fund raisers for our various programs. If you do not wish to buy the meal, please eat before you come to the Post or wait until the meal is done. Please do not bring in your own snacks, sodas, water, or any item we sell at the bar at any time.

When you sign in a guest, that guest must leave when you leave.

Steak Bingo is conducted at 6 PM every Friday steak night. Eight games are conducted-7 for steaks and 1 for road kill (ribs).

As a reminder, the bartenders' priority is serving drinks to customers at the bar and in the line. If you wish to be served, use the waitress station-do not stand at the end of the bar or between people sitting at the bar. If you want to redeem or buy a ticket for any machine, you will have to wait until the bartender finishes with drinks. The Post has 72 hours to pay out on the machines and the bartenders cannot pay tickets of \$500 or more or prior day tickets. You are limited to redeeming \$1,000 a day. If the bartender runs out of money, you may have to return later. The Manager will only redeem tickets Monday through Friday during normal business hours.

We serve lunch Monday—Friday from 11 AM to 1 PM.

Control ads and advertisers: Go to your Ad settings and turn off options for "Ads based on your use of websites and apps" and "Ads on apps and websites off of Facebook companies."
